<i>Primula vulgaris</i> *	N Mediterranean transitional
<i>Ranunculus calandrinioides</i>	Africa NW (Atlas Mts)
<i>Romulea bulbocodium</i> *	general Mediterranean
<i>Silene schafta</i>	NE Mediterranean transitional
<i>Solanum crispum</i> 'Glasnevin'	Chile
